

CBRL Cookies Policy

The CBRL website does not require visitors to sign in or submit any personal details and as such, does not use any cookies.

If you are a member or a registered user, if you log in to the membership space the website uses a cookie session to identify your browser as connected with your membership details. The session cookie's lifetime is determined by the time that you remain on the site.

No tracking or advertising cookies are used on the CBRL website.

What are cookies

Cookies are small pieces of text sent by your web browser by a website you visit. A cookie file is stored in your web browser and allows the website to recognise you and make your next visit easier, making the website more useful to you.

Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies.
